MOSAIC – Sudbury Community House Art Project – Phase Two

CISV Perth and the local community came together to beautify the Sudbury Community House – a meeting place for local groups. This Mosaic project was phase two of this project. The aim of the project was to establish a community partnership for our Perth chapter and celebrate diversity in the suburb of Mirrabooka. This second phase of beautifying the community house engaged local Aboriginal artists who worked on a mural to transform a plain fence at the community house. In the lead up to the event, community members painted tiles and these were later transformed into works of art to hang on fences and walls.

The project has positively impacted CISV Perth and the community members of the culturally diverse suburb, Mirrabooka. CISV Perth has continued the relationship with this community partner and we look forward working together in educational content areas including Diversity and Human Rights.

The generous support of the PACE Foundation enabled the working group to get further funding of \$1400 from the local council, and a grocery store. I have included a financial report of the project as well as some photos.
