## IJR Candidacy

To support my candidacy, I developed a video, questionnaire and a survey for Local and National JBs for the 2017-2018 Junior Branch Self Evaluation Tool.

### Junior Branch Self Evaluation Tool

I restructured the Junior Branch Self Evaluation Tool (JB SET) to follow a goal-based evaluation model,

improved the response rate to 85% of National JBs, including 100% response rate by the Asia Pacific Region,

completed an in-depth analysis of Junior Branch achievements in 2017-2018, published as a report to be found on the IJB Website,

and led a focused problem-solving session at the Global Conference, attended by 100+ CISV leaders regarding the findings of JB SET.

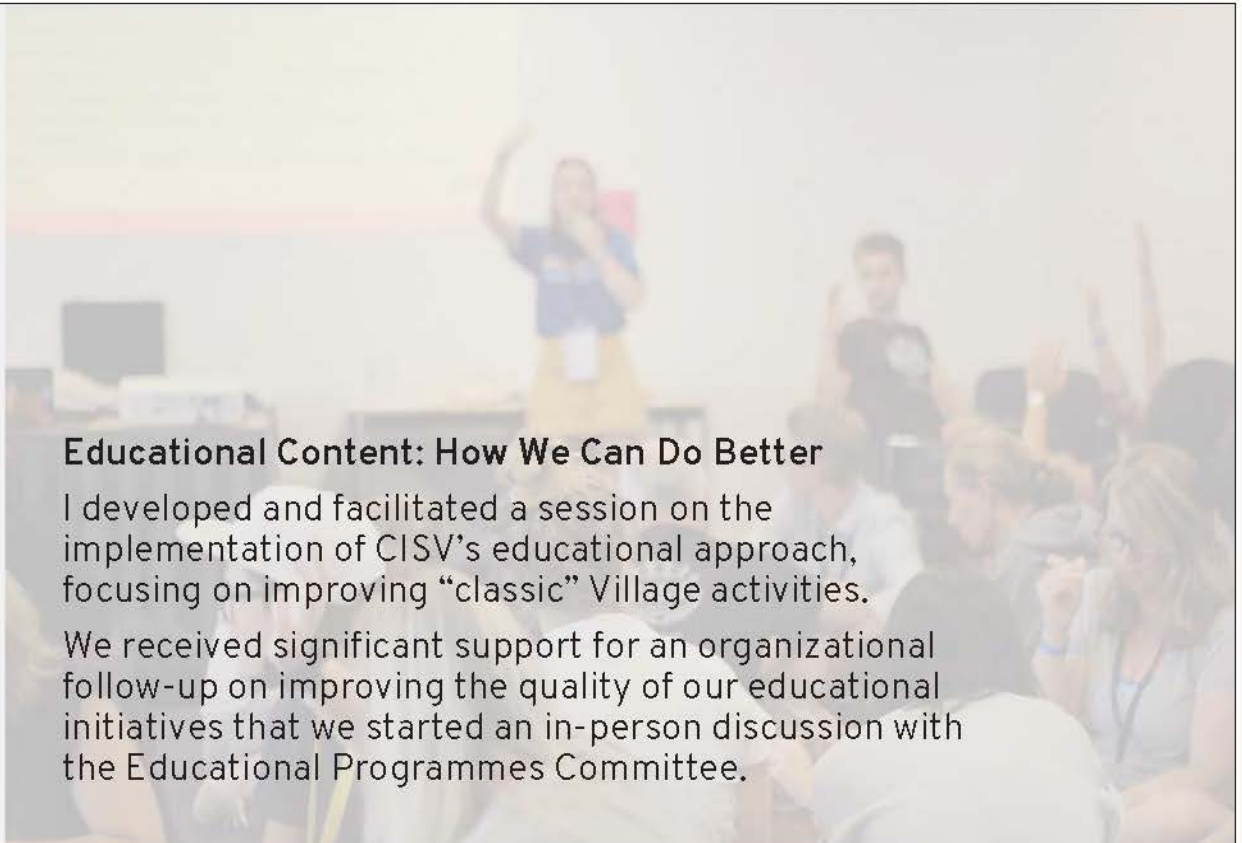
## Global Conference Session Presenter

I developed and facilitated a session on the implementation of CISV's educational approach, focusing on improving "classic" Village activities.

We received significant support for an organizational follow-up on improving the quality of our educational initiatives that we started an in-person discussion with the Educational Programmes Committee.

### Inspiring For Action: Design Thinking and Passion Projects for CISV

The session received positive feedback for being highly hands-on, implementable, and out-of-the-box.
